PAYMENT PLANS

- A. Tuition Guarantee Plan—Undergraduate Student Cash Plan. Pay in cash by August 15 the full estimated charges for the year (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) to guarantee the tuition rate.
- B. Cash Discount Plans. Pay total yearly estimated charges by August 15 (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) to receive a 5% discount on expenses not covered by financial aid. Pay total semester's estimated charges by August 15 and December 15 (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) to receive a 2% discount on expenses not covered by financial aid.
- C. Installment Plan. Arrange installment payments for estimated 'out-of-pocket' expenses for the semester before each semester begins.
